

Etiquette for dog owners outside built-up areas

Dog owner, this is how you take other people and animals into consideration outside built-up areas.



Get your dog used to different people, sounds, and things to make it easier for you to move around with him.



Between 1 March and 19 August, dogs older than 5 months must be kept on a leash or so that they may be immediately put on a leash.

§ HUNTING ACT



Between 20 August and 28 February, a dog may be kept off leash with permission of the landowner or the holder of the hunting right.

§ HUNTING ACT



If your dog deviates from your hunting area while hunting, go and collect your dog within half an hour.

§ HUNTING ACT



If you hunt in the north, find out in advance where reindeer herding work is in progress and train your dog not to go after reindeer.



Do not let your dog greet other dogs or people without permission.



Always keep your dog on leash when hiking in national parks or nature conservation areas.

§ NATURE CONSERVATION ACT



Do not take your dog to a ski track maintained for public use, unless it is specifically allowed.

§ PUBLIC ORDER ACT



You are allowed to go on a public exercise track with a leashed dog.
